

Branding requirements Michelin 992 Endurance Cup powered by Porsche Motorsport

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Compulsory branding on driver suit

Referring to art. 22.8.2 of the Sporting Regulations, each driver must place a Michelin badge and a 992 Endurance Cup badge on the upper chest area, as indicated below.

Further, any logos, prints, badges or stickers from any other tyre brand on the driver's equipment are prohibited.



Pit Lane requirements

Any logos, prints, badges or stickers from any other tyre brand may not be visible in the pit lane or in the pit box. This also includes any clothing for the team crew.

Parc Ferme and podium requirements

Referring to art. 35 of the Sporting Regulations, it is highly appreciated if all drivers on the podium wear their race suit, with the Michelin and 992 Endurance Cup badges as described above.

All podium drivers will be handed a Michelin cap which must be worn in Parc Ferme and on the podium.

Compulsory stickers on car

Referring to art. 1.9 of the Technical Regulations, the below stickers must be placed on the car according to the instructions provided.

 COMPULSORY STICKERS	
1	Door Panels - 49x37 cm To be displayed on each side of the car
2	Porsche front windshield banner
3	Creventic rear windshield banner
4	Class sticker - 20x5,7 cm To be placed on the rear number plate
5	Michelin To be placed on the front number plate and 2x corner backside of the car
6	PAGID Racing wing plate PAGID Racing sticker to be placed on each car side wing
7	CASELINER Mudguard left front - 40x10cm May not be placed on horizontal surfaces
8	NIOLALET Mudguard right front - 40x10cm May not be placed on horizontal surfaces
9	HRX Mudguard right rear - 40x10cm May not be placed on horizontal surfaces
10	Akrolegis mudguard left rear 40x10cm May not be placed on horizontal surfaces



Compulsory truck sticker

Referring to art. 7 of the Sporting Regulations, the truck sticker for the event must be placed on the top rear corner of the team's race trailer. See the image below.
